Come and examine hundreds of pieces of World War II-era mail and documents related to the Nazi's attempted extermination of the Jews. This collection is owned by the Florence and Laurence Spungen Family Foundation.

The ultimate goal of the exhibit is to bring to life the story of one of the most profound moral atrocities in human history that ever existed: the Holocaust. The exhibit pieces are living proof of the horrors that took place during World War II. Visitors have the incredible opportunity to touch the pieces and physically connect with any item they find interesting. Textbooks and movies are extremely valuable in learning about the Holocaust but this exhibit is unique because it allows visitors to hold each item and "feel the horrors."

This exhibit will be available for public viewing in the Marino Gymnasium from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.
