Margit and Jenő Gruner, with ten-year-old Agnes, were Jewish Hungarians living in Budapest at the time of the Nazi invasion. After the Gruners were forced into a “Jewish Designated” or “Yellow Star” building, their Catholic housekeeper took Agnes to safety. Agnes lived as her niece: a hidden child living in the open but living in fear. Raoul Wallenberg saved Jenő Gruner by hiding him in one of their safe houses. Margit Gruner was deported and perished in the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp. Agnes’s story of survival, perseverance, and devotion to family is told in her book, *A Roll of the Dice*.
