## New Holocaust Exhibit

### in Lake & Marion Counties

Come & examine hundreds of pieces of World War II-era mail & documents related to the Nazi's attempted extermination of the Jews (collection owned by the Florence & Laurence Spungen Family Foundation).

The goal of the new exhibit is to bring the life story of one of the most profound moral atrocities in human history that ever existed: the Holocaust. The exhibit pieces are living proof of the horrors that took place during World War II. Visitors have the incredible opportunity to touch the pieces and physically connect with any item they find interesting.

Textbooks and movies are extremely valuable in learning about the Holocaust but this exhibit is unique because it allows visitors to hold each item and "feel the horrors" others had to face during this horrific time.
