On the upper card, the sender is identified as Julius <u>Israel</u> Hess; on the lower card, Marie <u>Sara</u> Weiner. Both had to be handed to a postal clerk and checked.

15-pfennig outgoing portion of message-and-reply postal card properly paid surface postage to Sweden, canceled March 14, 1941, at Frankfurt, censored at Berlin; 100-pfennig plus 5-pfennig Hindenburg Medallion stamps properly paid post card postage (15 pfennigs), air mail surcharge (40 pfennigs), and special delivery fee (50 pfennigs), canceled July 22, 1941, at Vienna, censored at Frankfurt, arrived at New York on August 7, 1941.
