

Lithuanian Displaced Persons Camp

UNRRA = Established in 1943, the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration (1943) was the 1st UN organization before the General Assembly was established in 1945. With the chaos in Europe after the war, the UNRRA helped resettle about 7,000,000 people, 1,000,000 of which went through the displaced persons camps. The UNRRA setup a series of camps separated for nationals of Poland, Estonia, Ukraine, Latvia, and Lithuania.

Displaced Lithuanians after the war were sent to a camp in Ludwig Dillingen. Notes (in "units") for Lithuanians came in two colors; white for men and lilac for women.

The Lithuanian text on the reverse side states: The falsification and counterfeiting of camp marks is a punishable offense.

Illustrated are three notes for men: 1 unit, 2 units, and 10 units
